The mystery of the Holy Trinity is a truth that exists only in the Christian Faith. Actually other religions accuse us of being “polytheistic” for the single fact that we mention three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit in one God. Many people in history tried to explain this mystery, which is really non explainable by simple reason; we need the help of faith.

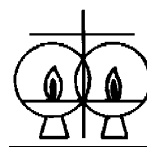
Many images have been employed in the past, like the triangle (three angles and one geometric figure), the shamrock (three petals and one flower), tripod (three legs and one table) but these can only be taken as similarities, not really explanations.

Many philosophers, from Aristotle to St. Thomas Aquinas have used different analogies in order to get close to the mystery, but this truth remains always a mystery.

So where did we get that? Like all the rest of Christian truths, we have received them from revelation, both the Old Testament and especially the New Testament. We have the three visitors of Abraham, who speak in the same vision as one; we have in the Genesis God using the “we” when he creates man: Let “us” make man according to our own image; many prophets speak of the “Son of Man” and the “Spirit of the Lord”.

But the clear revelation is from Jesus, the Son of God. He is one of the three persons and comes from there, where God lives. He continually mentions “His Father”; that he does everything for His Father; that His Father is greater than He, and at the same time that He is the same with the Father. At Pentecost Jesus promises the Holy Spirit, which is from the Father and the Son. And the Holy Spirit will explain everything that Jesus has taught us from the Father.

But what does it really mean the Holy Trinity for us today? St. Elizabeth of the Cross has spoken widely about the “inhabitation of the Holy Trinity” in our heart. It is also a great mystery that God almighty has chosen to live in our heart. It is awesome the fact that He prefers to stay with us instead of enjoying the beatitude of the Angels and Saints in heaven. How lucky are we humans? And what an awesome mystery that God creator of the Universe is hidden inside our heart!
