

A GREAT THANKS

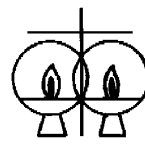

THE SIN, THAT CANNOT BE FORGIVEN

In the Gospel today we have one of the most troublesome statements of Jesus: “Whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit, can never have forgiveness”! What does it mean? That God cannot forgive our sins? The Pharisees called Jesus “crazy” (out of His mind) and “beelzebul” (which is the name of the devil). So considering him as a devil, was exactly the opposite of what He really was. They accused Him to be the devil, so they could never receive the forgiveness of God from a devil! That is why Jesus said that they will never be forgiven; not so much that God does not want or is not able to forgive, but that they did not want the forgiveness of God from one that they considered a devil. For us today, if we do not accept the sovereignty of God on us, we will not be able to receive His forgiveness. If we do not accept the “Spirit of God” who comes to us through Jesus, we are blaspheming against Jesus, not recognizing His Holy Spirit (which is the same for the Father and the Son). I have found people so proud that they will never submit to any commandment of God; I found incredible people who hated God with a passion, with no reason! They will never accept and receive the forgiveness of God! What a scary eternal destiny!
