

A HOMETOWN COME BACK.

Jesus is coming back to Nazareth with his disciples, after a great tour in the capital, Jerusalem, of many miracles and success stories; but He was not able to impress his town folks. The gospel says that many were “astounded” but then realizing that he was just a carpenter, son of an unknown poor woman, they “took offence at him.” Sad is the conclusion that Jesus draws from this rejection: “A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown... and in his own house”.

This is a sad situation repeated many times even in our own house; probably many people are happy with us, with our job and our performance, but when we get home, we feel the cold rejection of our own; many times they are not able to see our real value, our real love.

As a consequence what happened to Jesus is happening to us; we are not able to produce good deeds, because we feel rejected. “Jesus could not do any deed of power there”. It is as if we were in chains, blocked in our own frustration and lack of self-value.

And Jesus went to other villages! How many times we go to other places to find a bit of recognition, a bit of self-worth.

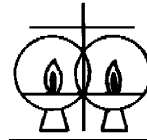

Our family should be the central place for self-worth. Our spouse and children should find in us the positive support they need in order to do good and great deeds. Too many times our children and our spouses suffer from a stagnant lack of self-worth. Miracles are possible only where there is an environment of self-worth and support around us.
