

A DIFFERENT MESSIAH.

After Jesus had announced a “new kingdom” with the Beatitudes on top of the mountain, he comes down to Galilee to present the real nature of the Kingdom that He came to establish. Very interesting to see that even the disciples were discussing who was going to be more powerful and important in this new Kingdom, and Jesus tells them clearly: “Whoever wants to be first, must be last and the servant of all.” It is a total turnover of the world’s mentality, where everybody wants to be first, on top of everybody else.

The way of Jesus is humility and simplicity. That is why Jesus takes a little child and presents it to the disciples as an example to follow. If you receive as little child, with the same attitude of a little child, you will receive Jesus Himself.

In my family, am I the first or the last? Do I serve the others or want to be served by others? Am I envious of my brothers or my siblings? Do I accept to be the last and servant of all, if I want to follow Christ?

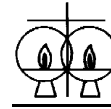
YOUTH MINISTRY
