THE MOST IMPORTANT COMANDMENT, and the only one.

In the Gospel of this Sunday Jesus answers to the scribe's question about the "first commandment" with a very simple statement: "You shall love your God and your neighbor." At first this seems to be a very simple and easy thing to do, but in reality it is a difficult challenge, which engages the whole person for a lifetime.

Love is a virtue that we have to learn. It is associated with generosity and self-giving. The greatest enemy of love is selfishness, because instead of being open to others, selfishness locks a person in himself.

Love is interested on the other person and works to see the person he loves happy and fulfilled. His happiness is not found in himself, but on the happiness of the other. Self-interest is again the greatest enemy of the real love.

Basically, love means self-sacrifice for the person we love.

The best example is the love of a mother. She is not paid for it, she does not have a work schedule, she does not expect anything in return. It is pure love, because there is no second interest in it.

That is why Jesus is giving us a command. Can love be commanded? Yes! This type of love is not a feeling or an emotion, but it grows out of a commitment to God. This love goes much beyond the human nature; it is a spiritual virtue, which must be acquired and practiced with the help of God, as an answer to His command.

And if we do this we will fulfill all the requirements of the "law and the prophets"; and so we will be able to enter into the Kingdom of God. This is the real reward of those who will learn to love in the way Jesus has commanded us to. Later in the Gospel, Jesus will say: "Love one another as I have loved you". Love is the fulfillment of the Law. The whole life will not be enough to love the way of Jesus; that is why we will have the whole eternity to experience the totality of love, which is God Himself
