This Sunday we have three great topics.

First of all the Church calls us to be aware and pray for so many migrants and refugees in our communities. Actually we ALL are migrating from a place to another, from one situation to another, from one country to another; and finally we all will migrate to heaven. But now migrating has become a crime and a disgrace; we have to counter act this trend, which is inhuman and anti-Christian. "I was a stranger" – said Jesus – "and you welcomed me!" If we do not welcome strangers, we do not welcome Jesus.

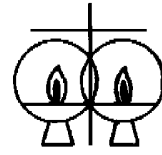
This week will be a time of prayer for Christian Unity. It is the last desire of Jesus, before his passion: "Father, that they may be one, as you and I are one". How can we still say that we believe in Christ and then we do not welcome other Christians? We are all united in the same faith and in the same Baptism; why can't we be united also in our church? Let us pray together. Again I invite you to make a sign of welcome to someone who is not "catholic"; maybe you could go with him/her to her Christian Church and pray together.

The Gospel today is presenting to us the beautiful miracle at the wedding in Cana of Galilee. Many are the teachings and the signs in this passage, but we would like to stress the point that Jesus begins his public ministry at a wedding. The Christian Marriage is the cradle of the divine work of Jesus; the family and the church are born together; it is at this wedding where the disciples begin to really believe in Jesus. Everything happens inside the family; human life, spiritual life, social life and human development. The family is the beginning of everything human and spiritual. As we continue to pray this year for the family, let us be aware that our most important work both human and spiritual happens IN THE FAMILY.

To build a Christian family is not easy, but it is the greatest achievement of any Christian human being.
