

ONE OF TEN

The gospel story of this Sunday's liturgy is very enlightening. Not because only one out of ten lepers came back to thank the Lord, but because that one who came back received a double grace: the cure from leprosy and the faith in Jesus.

This story teaches us that if we are grateful to God, He can do wonders in our life. This story is also the story of our life. More than ten times in our life we were like lepers; more than ten times we fell into our sins, which are real leprosy of our soul, and Jesus has cured us in one single stroke every time we have run to Him. It is interesting to see that Jesus told the men to go and show themselves to the priests of the temple; a clear reference to the sacrament of confession. More than ten times we too have gone to confession to the priests. It is also interesting to see that they were cured while they were going to the priests, not before. So in a way they trusted the words of Jesus and they started their way to the temple, and because they had trusted Jesus, they were cured. Once they realized they were cured, maybe they lit a candle to St. Anthony and went home happy.

Only one of them came back to say thank you, and that was a Samaritan, a foreigner, a pagan. And here's the greater healing, the healing of the soul, the enlightening of the mind, the faith in Jesus. Because of his gratitude, the tenth leper was ready to receive the ultimate healing, eternal life. He received double healing because of his gratitude, healing of the body and healing of the soul.

Do we have gratitude or resentment in our hearts? The mercy of God reigns in a grateful heart.

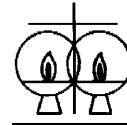
