

“If you are a King, save yourself!”

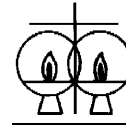
The basic difference between the kings of the world and Christ, the King, is that most of them look out for themselves, while Christ is looking not for himself but for others. Classical example of the leadership of Jesus is the image of the “Good Shepherd”, who carries the lost sheep on his shoulders. Let us consider a few images and parables that will help us discover the real face of Christ’s kingship.

First, the Lamb, sacrificed for the forgiveness of sinners. He leads by sacrifice. He is the first to pay with his own life, for the salvation of us all. The Lamb is leading us to sacrifice and forgiveness.

Secondly He established the New Kingdom, at the beginning of His public ministry. A new reality, which comes to replace the old order of things; a new way of living together, a new society for the good of all.

Third, the Shepherd who takes care of the sheep, especially those weak and pregnant. A leader who “smells” like his people, who is a part of the life and problems of his people. Finally, a Universal King, who will guide and establish peace on the whole universe. There is no limit or boundaries to the power of this king. All living beings are subject to him.

We Christians believe that this new kingdom is among us. We believe that our king is victorious and will control and organize the rest of humanity in a reign of peace and joy. We dare to believe in our King against the opposite opinion that everything is falling apart. Yes, because our King has already gained victory against the worst enemy of all: death. This is our guarantee that any other evil will be defeated, as death was defeated by resurrection. We are not afraid to believe; we are confident in our King.
