THE LAW AND THE HEART

"I have come not to abolish the law, but to fulfill it". Then Jesus in today's Gospel speaks about murder, adultery, divorce and false witness. Pretty heavy subjects, but what really counts in all this, is the attitude we have in reference to the law: Exterior versus interior; legalistic versus humanitarian.

Murder, adultery, divorce and false witness are all different faces of the same reality: death. There are many ways you can kill a man or a woman. In another passage Jesus said the "the law kills, while the spirit gives life".

The heart and the spirit are the life of the law. If we separate the two, we only end up in death. When the law is applied to physics, we need nothing else, but when the law is applied to humans, we need the heart and the spirit of the law, because humans are made of body and soul. Even in civil courts we have the appeal for humanitarian reasons.

But which "spirit" should we apply? Naturally the best, which is the spirit of God, brought to us by Jesus himself. That is why Jesus tells us in every case: "You were told..., but I will say to you..." And in this Jesus does not waver a bit! In effect His law is even stricter than the law of Moses. Yes, because He points to the deeper root of our behavior and because the human heart is at the center of all human activities. The heart is the motivating factor of all our actions.

Do I know my heart? Do I manage my heart, or do I let the emotions control my heart?
