

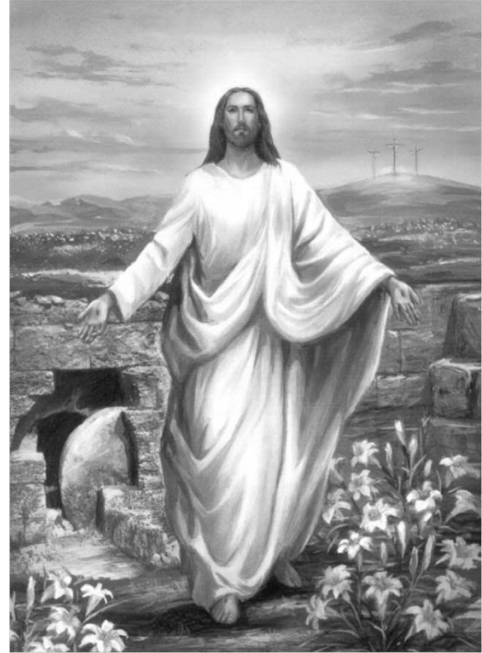
EASTER VIRUS SUNDAY.

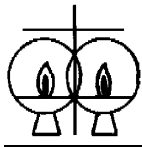
