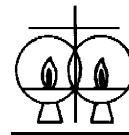
“His thoughts are not our thoughts” and his ways are not our ways”.

In the Gospel, Jesus gives us a clear example of the difference of how our God looks at us in the parable of the landowner and the workers of the last hour. According to our marketing mentality, the more hours you work, the more money you are entitled; the less hours you work, the less money you are entitled. But God does not follow our marketing laws, especially if we consider that his “usual daily wage” is eternal recompense, that is eternal life. If you only have eternal wages, you cannot go by the hours you have given to the Lord because you are going to always receive an eternal wage.

For God, it is not important how many hours you have been working in the field, from early morning or from the last hour, because His recompense can only be eternal. The important thing is to be able to be invited to the field and participate in the work of the Kingdom and then to be rewarded by the landowner. God can only give eternal wage, so it really does not matter if you have been working from early morning or from the last hour.

“Friend, are you envious because I am generous?” God only wants the chance to fill us with his eternal gifts; He does not measure his love by the amount of our goodness, but He gives according to His generosity, which is eternal. Are we able to imitate our God, who is so generous? Do we expect others to give us their time and love or are we generous in giving of ourselves, like God is giving to Us?

If our ways are not like God’s ways, it is up to us to open our hearts and become like Him, generous in mercy and compassion.
