

**YOU DO NOT KNOW NEITHER THE DAY,
NOR THE HOUR**

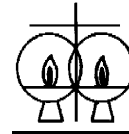
The liturgy of the word today is centered on the virtue/gift of WISDOM. In the first reading we learn how to obtain wisdom: “she is easily discerned by those who love her”. If we put together intelligence and love of God, we find wisdom. Intelligence is not enough to discern what God wants in our life; we need His love. “Wisdom makes herself known to those who desire her”. We have to desire her, to search for her and then we will find it “early morning sitting at the gate”.

All is pointing to our constant and daily journey of love and faith, which is at the basis of our life as Christians.

In the parable of the Gospel, the theme of Wisdom appears again in the parable of the ten bridesmaids given by Jesus. The oil (like the wine) in the bible is the symbol of charity and love. We must spend a full life of love, if we want to be able to participate in the nuptial banquet of the Lamb, that is to enter into eternal life. The five foolish bridesmaids did not fill their hearts with love, probably they were too busy with too many other things, so when the hour came to have their lamps full of love, it was too late. At the same time love is something very personal; it cannot be borrowed from someone else; love comes from the inner self of each person. It would be like an airplane pilot who forget to fill the tank of fuel oil for a long trip and then find himself in the middle of the ocean with the tank empty. At that point it will be too late. The same for the foolish bridesmaids, when the groom came, they were not ready, and they remain outside the banquet hall.

The response of the master to their plea has been very strong: “I do not know you!” And the bridesmaids could not enter into the banquet. And Jesus ends the parable by saying: “Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour”.

During these pandemic times, many “prophets of doom” are spreading messages of fear, creating a lot of confusion for the simple faithful. DON’T BELIEVE A THING THEY SAY. Believe instead the word of Jesus, which tells us to be prepared, but not to search for the time or the hour, which is only up to the Father. People are talking about “The Warning”; be prepared, but don’t believe them. People talk about the “three days of darkness”; be prepared but don’t believe them. People talk about the “imminent coming of Jesus in glory”; be prepared but don’t believe them. People are moving out of the city, because they say it is safer in the outskirts; be prepared, but don’t believe them. We have the Gospel and that is enough. If we are ready, all these signs can come at any time in any place and we will be ready to accept them, both good or bad. Let us trust the providence of God and just be ready!
