

PENTECOST SUNDAY

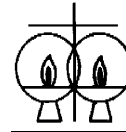
The Holy Spirit is the Love of the Father and the love of the Son combined in the third person. He is holy and He is a Spirit, like the Father and the Son. Our rich catholic tradition offers many names of the Holy Spirit; some of them will help us to know a bit deeper the third person of the Holy Trinity.

He is “the Promise of the Father”, as Jesus said, and Jesus ascended to heaven to release this promise of the Father on the Church and on humanity. He is the “spouse of the Blessed Mother”; He is the expression of the Love of the Father and of the Son toward the simple girl of Nazareth, Mary, the Mother of Jesus. Mary conceived Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit.

He is “light from above” which enlightens the souls of the faithful in their journey of faith to the mysteries of God’s life.

He is “author of all good”; every good thing comes from Him, especially in relation to the eternal life with God. He is the fountain of “living water” that gushed forth from the heart of Jesus. He is the “consuming fire” of love, which never extinguishes in the heart of the faithful. He is the “spiritual unction” which soothes and consoles the faithful in the harshness of life. He is the “spiritual union”, a mystical relationship with the spouse of our soul. He is Spirit of truth and love, of wisdom and understanding, of counsel and fortitude. He is a “spirit of mercy and forgiveness”, in fact Jesus gave the Holy Spirit to the Apostles “for the forgiveness of sins”. He is the “Spirit of modesty and innocence”, especially needed in our troubled times; He is the “Spirit of humility and chastity”; two virtues strictly related to his nature as spouse. He is the “comforter” of souls, especially in times of trials and persecution. He is the “Spirit of prayer”; in fact, He himself is the one inspiring the prayers in the heart of the faithful. He is the “sanctifier” of the Church, which makes the seven sacraments alive in the hearts of the believers. He “governs the Church” through disciples, ministers, deacons, priests, Bishops and Pope; He is the one “leading” the Church of Christ. He is the one that “keeps the universe alive”; no life is possible without the Holy Spirit. He is the one who welcomes the “adopted children of God” into his Church. The Holy Spirit is the action of God in the world today.

Come Holy Spirit and kindle the light of your love in the heart of all the faithful.

Vatican summit on 'theology of the priesthood' will look at questions raised in recent synods.

The title of the symposium is: "Toward a Fundamental Theology of the Priesthood," and will take place from February 17-19, 2022 in the Vatican. It is intended to reflect on the issues raised by the last 3 synods of the Family, of Youth and of the Amazon, including priestly celibacy, dwindling vocations, and the role of women in the Church. As a parish we will pray and follow up on those important issues in our church.
