“Jesus saw a great crowd and He had compassion of them, because they were like sheep without a Shepherd.”

The liturgy begins this Sunday with a stern warning: “Wo to the shepherd who destroy and scatters the sheep of my pasture!”

God is disappointed for many shepherds that today instead of guiding the flock to the righteous pastures, they destroy and scatter. It is easy today to think about all the scandals of the clergy abuse and the ongoing scandals for mismanagement of the funds of the faithful. It is easy to point fingers to politicians and magistrates for laws that go directly contrary to the real common good of their people. We are sick with bad news day after day in the newspapers and on the media. It seems that everything is falling apart: persons, family, church, society... the whole world.

God must be even more disappointed, because He sent His Son to teach us to live in a beautiful Kingdom of God, but it seems that we are doing everything we can to destroy it. We could go on and on, as the media does, but the Lord invites us to become GOOD SHEPHERDS. Men and women with principles; people of great vision and openness to the real needs of our neighbors.

Am I a good shepherd in my family? Am I a good guide for my children? Do I offer an example of real Christian life? Am I open to welcome even people who are different or think the opposite of my convictions? How do I help the community in which I live, to build a better world? Instead of complaining and gossiping about the politicians, what can I do to make a difference in my neighborhood? Even in my church, how do I participate and give of my time and talent? It is easy to criticize the priest or the minister or the volunteer! But, what am I doing to make my church more vibrant and welcoming? Am I interested in building a real community of faith and love?

We all have someone under our responsibility; we all are shepherds in some way. What am I doing to become a better shepherd? God said that He will raise up a “righteous branch”. What does it mean for me to be “a righteous shepherd”? Am I searching for “holiness”? Am I guiding my family, my community up toward righteousness or down toward despair?

“Then I myself will gather the remnant of my flock! I will raise up shepherds over them who will shepherd them, and they shall not fear any longer, nor shall any be missing”, says the Lord.
