FIVE BARLEY LOAVES for FIVE THOUSAND PEOPLE, and 12 baskets of LEFTOVER

The incredible mystery of the Holy Eucharist is at the center of today's liturgy.

The prophet Elisha, in the first reading, askes his servant to distribute twenty loaves of barley to one hundred people and reassures him that there will be enough for all and even some left over. Jesus, in the gospel multiplies five loaves for five thousand people and again there were twelve baskets of leftover. A big numerical difference between the two, but the same symbol! The first miracle was a foreshadowing of the second. But even the second miracle is a very little thing in reference to the multiplication of the sacred bread (the Holy Communion) that Jesus offers every day to people all over the world for so many centuries.

The Eucharist cannot be understood by people without faith. It is in a level above the natural, above the material realm. It is strictly a divine mystery! In order to understand the Eucharist, we have to move to another level of consciousness, the divine, the mystical sphere. It is incomprehensible to our human mind how God almighty can reduce Himself to become a "thing"; He is the giver of life and becomes an inanimate thing; He the Lord of Lords is possessed and held by a miserable creature. He the all-powerful becomes vulnerable and impotent even to defend Himself.

Yet He is the reason for the existence of all the Universe. No human being could exist without his Spirit; no one could be saved, without His blood; no living thing could stay alive and any material being continue living without His direct interest and love. He is the "heart of the world" (as St. Paul says) and no creature could live without the heart.

The Church, the body of Christ, will be renewed beginning with the holiness of the priesthood, but the holiness of the priests will be renewed ONLY by the Holy Eucharist, which is the source and the summit of the Church. No priesthood = no Eucharist; no Eucharist = no church, no church = no grace, no holiness, no sacraments. Everything comes down from the Eucharist. Let us thank Jesus for this incredible gift He has given to His Church.

"Lord Jesus give us every day of this divine bread".
