ORDINARY**

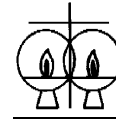
Jesus goes back to his hometown and is welcomed with rejection and ridicule. Isn't he the carpenter, the son of Mary? Don't we know his family? Where is his power coming from? Who does he think He is? They could not accept the extraordinary power of God in an ordinary man of their town. They thought they knew him so they could not accept the extraordinary action of God in this man of ordinary origin.

It is difficult to find the extraordinary action of God in the ordinary day-to-day events of our life. But that it is in the ordinary that we can find God! Actually, the ordinary is with us every day, so we have the opportunity to find God every day of our life.

St. Paul in the second reading tells us that we can find God even in the middle of our temptations. The thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan, was surely the presence of evil in his life; God did not take it away, on the contrary He left temptations in the life of Paul so that he would not fall into spiritual pride, because of his mystical experiences. Even in our life, God allows us to fall into temptations to keep humility in our soul.

That is the mystery of our life; while we experience the heavenly joy of the presence of Jesus in our lives, we have also to keep battling with our daily temptations and failings.

That is our ordinary life, mixed with graces and sins. And Jesus keeps telling us: "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness". That is the situation of us, human beings, living with a broken nature, among graces and sins. It is our challenge to recognize the great works of God in the middle of our shortcomings and sinful inclinations. However, it is in the ordinary and sinful daily life that God is present with his grace and mercy. When we have to walk and keep battling between failures and successes we can always rely on the grace of God, and that will be enough for us.
