

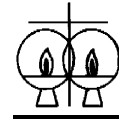
**YOU DO NOT KNOW WHAT YOU ARE ASKING!**

The two sons of Zabedee (James and John) were well esteemed among the disciples of Jesus; when they requested to have a place of honor and authority at the right hand of Jesus in His kingdom, Jesus did not reject them or scold them as He had done with Peter in another occasion. Probably even Jesus had a good appreciation of their genuine faith; as a matter of fact he said that they were going to drink his cup of sufferings but for the place at his right hand it was up to the Father and not up to Him.

But Jesus warned them to think twice before asking for something like that. "You don't know what you are asking for!"

This question is addressed specifically to us: Do we know the meaning of our calling? Do we know the real implication of the fact that we have been called at the right hand of Jesus? Maybe we do not have any authority in the church, but we all have our place at His side. As disciples we have already our place in the Kingdom of God. When we were baptized, we became "priests, prophets and Kings". It is clear that we all have an important function in the Kingdom of God. Do we know what we are asking when we take seriously our Baptism? Do we know what it means to be disciples?

Jesus gives a few explanations: "Whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant". Even "the Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve". Our greatness has to be in serving the interest of others. This is the deep meaning of real love: service and giving one's life for the ransom for many. This is exactly the opposite of what the world is looking for today. Power and glory belong to our finite world, while service and love belong to eternity. Would you prefer the glory of this world or the joyful love at the service of God for all eternity?
