

**THE KINGDOM OF GOD.**

What is it? How do we find it? How do we enter in it?

Actually, Jesus never told us what the Kingdom of God really is; He told us how to get into it. We could imagine the Kingdom of God as the "Garden of Eden" before the fall of Adam and Eve. The Kingdom of God is the original place where we were supposed to be living, but because of the original sin, we fell off the beauty, harmony and joy of the original creation of God for us. The Kingdom of God could be compared to the LIFE OF GOD, breaded into us at our creation.

Now, we have to find the way back to that original harmony, which is made of "justice, peace and love". Jesus came on earth, precisely to offer us the "way back" to the union with God, which we had before the original sin.

"Hear, o Israel, the Lord is our God, the Lord alone". This is the foundation and the beginning of any way back to the Father: we have to believe and follow the way to God.

"I am the way, the truth and the life" Jesus said to his disciples. He also simplified the process with two simple commandments: Love God and neighbors. So really it should not be too difficult to go back to the Kingdom of God, that is, a life of union with God himself.

BUT IT IS NOT EASY TO LOVE. It seems easy, but it takes a whole life for a Christian to love the way of Jesus, till death. To love is to sacrifice; to love is to deny oneself; to love is to give it all to God and neighbor; to learn how to love takes the whole human life. Only in heaven we will learn how to love the way God loves us. Then we will experience what the Kingdom of God is all about. How far are we from the Kingdom of God?

After Mass we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament around the Parking lot and from the steps of the Church we will ask the Blessing of Almighty God for the whole city of Mississauga. It is also the day of Halloween, so we ask Jesus to protect our children and our city from the powers of evil.
