

**THE END OF TIMES**

As we approach the end of the cycle of the Ordinary Time, the Liturgy invites us to reflect on the end of times, and so also at the end of our time.

In the first reading, the prophet Daniel gives us a pretty accurate description of the future. First, he tells us of Michael, the prince and protector of the people, who is coming in a “time of anguish” to deliver the people and all persons who are written in the book of life. After this time of anguish, there will be a time of judgment and those “who sleep in the dust” (the dead) and will be sent either to everlasting life or everlasting shame and everlasting contempt.

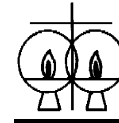
In the Gospel, Jesus speaks in the same terms to his disciples. He talks about the end of times as a “time of suffering”, where the sun and the stars will fall from heaven, and the “Son of Man will come with great power and glory”. Then He will send the angels to gather the elects.

Jesus also gives a sense of urgency because he says that “this generation will not pass away till all these things will take place”. At the same time, he warns us not to look for “the day or the hour” when this will happen, because only the Father knows it.

How should we interpret these signs? Certainly not in a literal sense, but analogical and spiritual. What we can surely understand is that: 1. There will be a time of anguish; 2. That stars and moon will fall into disgrace and sin; 3. That the Son of man will come in power and glory, to re-establish his kingdom on earth, and 4. He will be aided by Michael and the other angels.

This seems to be exactly our situation today. A lot of anguish; a lot of fallen stars, even in the church; surely there will be a judgment, in order to make right the wrongs of the earth; but finally, the Lord will return with power and in glory in the second coming.

“About that day or hour no one knows”. So it is useless to look in the internet for “prophesies” or “warnings” when the end of the world will be coming; nobody knows and if the Father did not let Jesus know when He was on earth, I am sure that the Father will not give any date to any “visioner” now on earth today.
