

MY LORD, do not pass by your servant.

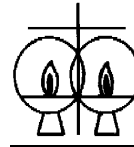
Today we could entitle this Sunday as a "HOSPITALITY SUNDAY".

In the first reading we have Abraham, who by welcoming three strangers to his tent, welcomes God himself, who in turn promises him a son, who was the ultimate goal of his life. The stranger is in many instances the cover of God himself, who comes to visit us. Imagine, if Abraham would have not bothered to invite those strangers, he would have lost the only chance to have a son, who was the only hope of his life. Equally, when we are not able to see the visitation of God through the strangers, we might lose the only chance of our life.

In the Gospel, we have another beautiful scene of friendship and hospitality. Jesus was always welcome at Martha's house in Bethany, together with her sister Mary and her brother Lazarus. That day Jesus had brought also "his disciples" so the work to take care of all those men was overwhelming. That is why she complains to Jesus about her sister doing nothing to help! I bet she was right, but Jesus does not go along this way, He reminds Martha that there are things much more important than good food. Actually, He seems to take Mary's side and said: "Martha, Martha you are worried by many things; there is need ONLY of one thing. Mary has chosen the better part".

But what is the better part? The personal relationship with Jesus! The rest is OK only when done as a result of this personal relationship with Jesus. Martha and Mary are two aspects of our spiritual life; we need both action and contemplation; Jesus was visiting their house because He loved both the loving contemplation of Mary and the active love of Martha.

In our life we need both Martha and Mary, but we have to start in the right order: First Jesus and then the rest.
