

**“BUT TO THE HUMBLE,  
God reveals his secrets.”**



The main theme of the liturgy of the world for this Sunday is HUMILITY. The word itself comes from the Latin word: Humus, that means soil, ground. Yes, because humility is at the bottom of all other virtues. You cannot be arrogant and loving; you cannot be arrogant and wise; you cannot have good faith if you are arrogant; you cannot be a good husband, a good father or even a good businessman without humility. Humility is the ground where you can plant all the good qualities that make up a good “human”. As you see the root of the word “human” comes also from “humus” the same root from where we derive the word humility. So, we can say that humility is at the bottom of being human. The arrogant is not human because he is without humility.

There is another important aspect of the virtue of humility: it is required in order to know God; “God reveals His secrets to the humble”.

Humility gives you the ability to receive the graces and the gifts of God. The heart who is not humble is like a closed door; God may be knocking from outside, but the arrogant is closed from inside, because he thinks that he does not need anything from anybody. Remember that God has created Adam from the earth (humus). We need to recognize that we are dust before we come to the rightful position as creatures in front of the creator. Only when we have taken the rightful position in front of God, with an attitude of humility, we will be able to relate to Him in the rightful way. The arrogant is positioned in the wrong place with reference to God. The arrogant is not spiritual, only selfish and deceived by his pride. Sometimes he even camouflages his pride with false humility,

“Perform your tasks with humility, then you will be loved by God and those who God loves.”
