

THE DAY OF THE LORD.

I really wish that we understand and live the “Day of the Lord” as a family and as a community. The day is made up of 24 hours, but when we talk of the “day of the Lord” we reduce it to one hour in church; and the other 23 hours? Do we give those hours to the Lord, to whom they belong?

So, we should plan the day of the Lord with events that are directed to the Lord.

1 - First, we should get up in the morning by remembering right away to praise the Lord. What a beautiful scene gathering the whole family in the living room and sing praises to the Lord, thanking Him for this new day in His honor.

2 - Then we can prepare breakfast TOGETHER, maybe preparing something special that mom or dad like, or one of the brothers and sisters love.

3 - Then we prepare to go to mass! It would be good to read together beforehand the gospel that we are going to hear in church.

4 - Once in church let us sit together! Jesus loves to see the whole family in front of Him. If anyone is called to minister (Altar Server, Lector or Eucharistic Minister) make sure you are ready 15 minutes before the celebration.

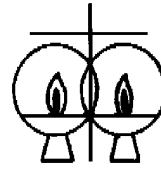
5 - After mass is the time to enjoy a walk together or a brief visit to some of our friends. And finally, a joyful lunch, preferably at home. It would be great to invite a relative or a friend, especially if you are involved in some sort of ministry together.

6 - The afternoon should be dedicated to FAMILY. Either by taking a walk/trip together or by visiting relatives and friends but most of all it is dedicated to GROWING in the faith. In the old days they used to have VESPERS with a conference given to the adults by the pastor. Nowadays we offer programs for the entire Family on Sundays.

7 - The conclusion of the “Day of the Lord” should be a Rosary together as a family and a supper all together. This is what it is a real “Day of the Lord”.

Another great idea is to celebrate the day of the Lord together with another family. That it would make it even more interesting especially for your children. Once a month it would be very useful to gather ten or fifteen families together and make it like a picnic or “Community Day” so that both children and parents would enjoy the mutual support of other families.

The Day of the Lord can really become a game changer for the joy and unity of the family and of the whole community! Don’t waste your most beautiful day shopping, or watching TV!!!
